Dear Mr. McIntosh:

1991-92 Realignment statute requires the Department of Finance (Finance) to develop a caseload growth schedule for specified social and health service programs in consultation with the Departments of Social Services and Health Care Services. Statute also requires the California State Association of Counties (CSAC) to review the schedule prior to its submission to the State Controller's Office (SCO). We have enclosed the 2011-12 caseload growth schedule for your review, which indicates growth of \$40.7 million statewide. Upon completion of CSAC's review, please submit a letter to Finance stating CSAC's concurrence with the schedule. Following receipt of this letter, Finance will submit the caseload growth schedule to the SCO.

Pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code section 17605(b)(1)(A), to the extent that 2011-12 sales tax revenue growth materializes, these revenues will be allocated first to the Caseload Subaccount of the Sales Tax Growth Account. Any remaining revenue growth will be allocated to the County Medical Services and General Growth Subaccounts of the Sales Tax Growth Account, pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code sections 17605.07 and 17605.10, respectively.
