## **Senate Committee Advances Budget Bills for Wednesday Floor Vote**

The Senate Budget and Fiscal Review Committee met this evening and approved a dozen additional budget trailer bills. All bills are in print; live links to the measures are included in the chart below.

Of note is the elimination of a proposed \$250 million sweep of property tax "pass through" funding. Counties wish to thank the Governor, Department of Finance, and legislative leaders for recognizing the importance of keeping this critical local funding local. The package of bills also includes seven measures related to 2011 Realignment, including the permanent fiscal "superstructure" (AB 1480) for 2011 Realignment.

The Senate Committee is expected to meet again tomorrow to wrap up a few more trailer bills, but it is not yet clear which measures will be considered.

After their work is done, the full Assembly and Senate are expected to vote on the measures on Wednesday, concluding the 2012-13 budget process (save for the implementation of \$6 billion in possible trigger cuts should the Governor's ballot initiative fail in November). CSAC is in the process of reviewing each of the measures below and will produce a detailed summary of the 2012-13 Budget Act package once it is passed by both houses of the Legislature.
