Budget Debates Begin

Today, the Senate and Assembly took up a number of budget trailer bills and sent some of them to the Governor, with the notable exclusion of the bill to eliminate redevelopment agencies. That bill, SB 77, was the first measure taken up by the Assembly this afternoon and it remained on call for hours while Governor Jerry Brown and Speaker John Pérez met with Assembly Members in an attempt to encourage a final 54th vote to move the bill to the Senate. The Senate adjourned for the evening at about 9:00 p.m. and the Assembly adjourned shortly thereafter, after allowing SB 77 to fail. Both houses are scheduled to return to session tomorrow at 11:00 a.m. to continue their budget work.
