  - Programs and services
  - Funding sources and capacities
  - Key performance measures
  - Governance
  - Geography and demographics
  - Branding, communications, and outreach

  - CDA team and the CA 2030 Steering Committee
  - AAAs and contracted AAA providers
  - Public agencies and departments peripheral to the aging network

  - Promising practices in other states and countries
  - Themes across AAA area plans and strategic plans
