Funding Distribution Timeline



- Dec. 14, 2018 Two separate administrative community-based organization (ACBO) Requests for Proposal (RFP), a regional and a statewide
 - Small community-based organizations should apply to the ACBOs in their region
- In accordance with state contracting procedures, specific requirements and corresponding timelines will be released on the aforementioned dates







