
#CaliforniansForAll College Corps



- Create debt-free pathways to college for students who commit to serve their community (California GI Bill)
- 6,500 Fellows over the next two years (roughly size of the Peace Corps)
- Includes AB 540 California Dream Act Students

- Help low-income students graduate college on time, with less debt, social networks, and professional skills.
