Graham Knaus provided a brief update on the state of the Association and provided several staff updates.

3. CARE Court Proposal & Homelessness

Graham Knaus and Jaqueline Wong-Hernandez provided an update on the Governor's CARE Court Framework.

4. Approval of Minutes from March 3, 2022

A motion to approve the minutes from March 3, 2022, was made by Supervisor Long; second by Supervisor Dillon. Motion carried unanimously.

5. Approval of IRS Form 990 – Tax Year 2020

A motion to approve IRS Form 990 – Tax Year 2020, was made by Supervisor Pedersen; second by Supervisor Lucero. Motion carried unanimously.

6. Consideration of the 2022-23 Budget & Salary Schedule

CSAC Treasurer, Supervisor Ed Scofield, presented the CSAC 2022-23 Budget and recommended that the Board of Directors:

a. Adopt the CSAC Proposed Budget and Salary Schedule for FY 2022-23 as approved by the Executive Committee on March 23, 2022.

A motion to adopt the CSAC Proposed Budget and Salary Schedule for FY 2022-23 was made by Supervisor Lucero; second by Supervisor Gallagher. Motion carried unanimously.

- b. Authorize the acceptance of an additional \$450,000 as approved by the CSAC Finance Corporation on April 7, 2022, as follows:
 - (a) \$250,000 in one-time funds to be recognized in the current fiscal year (FY 2021-22)
 - (b) \$200,000 in ongoing funds to be included in the CSAC Budget starting in FY 2022-23

A motion to authorize the acceptance of an additional \$450,000 as approved by the CSAC Finance Corporation on April 7, 2022, was made by Supervisor Peters; second by Supervisor Campbell. Motion carried unanimously.

c. Direct CSAC staff to amend the FY 2022-23 Proposed Budget to recognize the additional contribution by the Finance Corporation.

<u>A motion to amend the FY 2022-23 Proposed Budget was made by Supervisor Haschak; second by Supervisor Sabatier. Motion carried unanimously.</u>
