PREVENTION GRANT PROGRAM

The Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) is announcing the release of the Organized Retail Theft Prevention Grant Program, Request for Proposals (RFP). This RFP makes \$242,250,000 available competitively to city police, county sheriffs' departments, and probation departments, to support local law enforcement agencies in preventing and responding to organized retail theft, motor vehicle or motor vehicle accessory theft, or cargo theft.

Proposals must be received through the BSCC-Submittable Application portal by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, July 7, 2023. Additional information regarding the BSCC-Submittable Application portal, Proposal Instruction Packet, and required documents are available on the Organized Retail Theft Prevention Grant Program webpage.

A virtual Bidder's Conference will be held via Zoom on May 11, 2023 at 10:00 A.M. A link to the Bidders' Conference is provided within the RFP and will be posted on the BSCC website.
