



The funds have been distributed by several state agencies, across many fiscal years, allocated via dozens of different programs, and awarded to hundreds of agencies. As a result, it can be difficult to clearly determine what activities were funded, the amount of funding awarded, and the entities that received funding.

The two charts on this handout show how much the state has spent on housing and homelessness programs and what entities were awarded these funds. CSAC gathered publicly available information from a variety of state agencies and determined that between fiscal year 2019-20 to data available as of current fiscal year 2024-25, 10 state agencies have been allocated or awarded \$29.5 billion.


